METHODOLOGY

360 Camp is a multidisciplinary company with 12 years of experience in organising our own campaigns and programmes. Our work is based on three principles: quality, respect and safety.

The 360 Camp team is made up of a camp director, a coordinator, a lifeguard, a specialist in young people with special educational needs, a team of instructors and qualified teachers, selected for their charisma, enthusiasm and extensive experience in the sector.

It's time to have fun and learn. Children will enjoy a holiday in Spain while learning the Spanish language and culture. This camp is especially designed for children and teenagers who wish to benefit from effortless learning with natural educational methods.

LEVEL OF CHILDREN

This camp accepts any level of Spanish, from beginners to advanced. The groups will be formed according to the level of the children, with specialised instructors who will help them at all times, so that they feel comfortable and protected.

INSTRUCTORS

All the instructors are specialised in dealing with foreign children and speak more than one language. We have 4 qualified teachers who will be in charge of the Spanish classes and who will motivate the children to use Spanish throughout the day. There will be several groups for the Spanish classes. 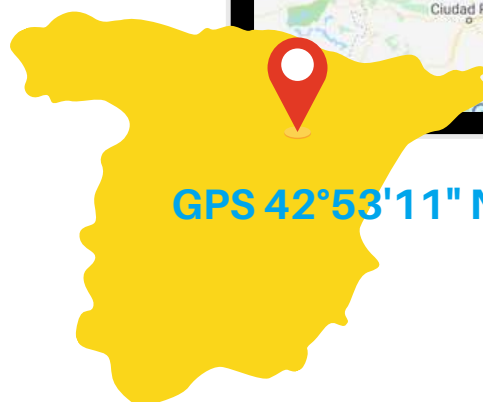
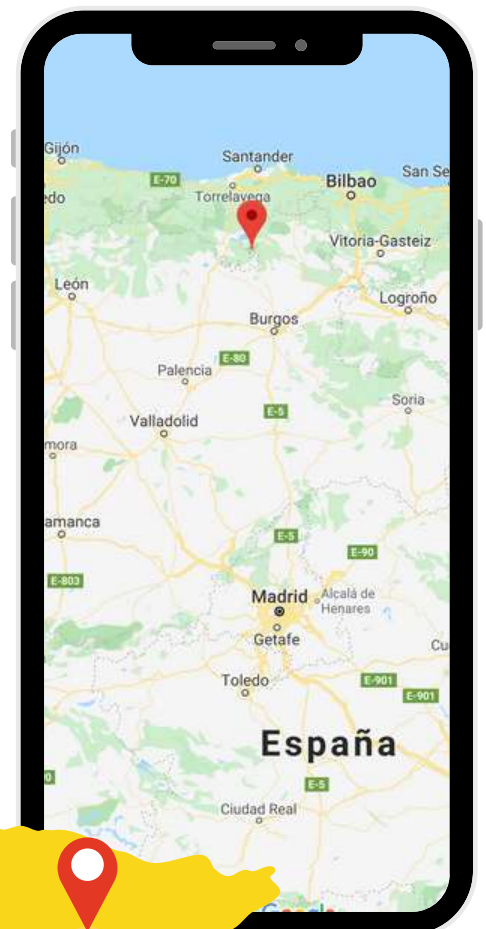
Albergue Los Arraques

MEALS

The food is prepared by the kitchen team on site. The staff prepares homemade and balanced menus.

Campers will enjoy four meals a day: breakfast, lunch, afternoon snack and dinner.

Of the 4 meals, at least 2 of them are hot meals. We have cooks who specialise in preparing homemade Spanish food for children.

At 360 Camp we adapt to your needs and we make special menus (for celiacs, diabetics, vegetarians...)



MEDICAL INFORMATION

All medical information will be treated with confidentiality. Please check it carefully and let us know if there are any errors or changes. It is very important to keep your medical information up to date.

Please let us know in case of any food intolerances or allergies.

The health and safety of the camper is our priority, so on the first day we will ask for the Social Security Health Card or Private Insurance.

We are not authorised to provide any type of medication by law. Therefore, if any camper requires medication during the camp, parents must give instructions to the person responsible in 360 Camp so that it can be administered accordingly.

If the camper suffers any incident, the parents or legal custodians will be informed immediately.

The camp has Civil Liability Insurance and Accident Insurance for all participants. If the children are members of the European Union, they must bring the European Health Insurance Card or similar.



CAMP RULES

The safety and enjoyment of campers is our priority.

At 360 Camp, we adhered to certain rules and regulations:

- Campers must obey and respect the monitors.
- Campers must respect their fellow campers, the materials, the facilities and the environment.
- The possession and/or consumption of alcohol and tobacco is prohibited.
- The use of mobile phones is restricted to the days and times of calls and may not be used as camera or alarm clock.
- If the camper finds something that is not theirs, they must take it to the lost and found box or hand it in to their monitor.
- During swimming and sports activities, all instructions provided by the monitors must be strictly adhered to.
- The use of bad language is prohibitive

MISCELLANEOUS

BIRTHDAYS

If the birthday coincides with the dates of the camp, we will facilitate a phone call, we will give them a present and we will sing "Happy Birthday" together. It will be an unforgettable memory.

LOST AND FOUND

It is important to label all campers' possessions brought to the camp with your name and surname, as this will make it easier to identify the owner if it is lost.

LONGING

Camps are a time of growth for children and young people, they take them out of their comfort zone, which is why it is very likely that they may have (especially the first few times) episodes of homesickness. These moments appear especially when talking to parents on the phone, so we invite you to follow these suggestions to help your child:

- Explain what the experience of sleeping away from home with other campers will be like.
- Allow the camper to bring a cuddly toy or object to accompany him/her in this experience.
- Explain that it is normal for them to miss their family.
- Say goodbye quickly and simply, without conveying concern to the camper.

RECEPTION AND “PICK-UP” OF CAMPERS

Options:

1. SHUTTLE SERVICE FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE CAMP AND BACK (ALBERGUE LOS ARRANES AT VILLAMEDIANA DE LOMAS, BURGOS, SPAIN)

A 360 Camp instructor will pick up and drop off your child at the terminal of the different airports: **Madrid, Santander or Bilbao.**

You must send an email to **campamentos@360camp.es** 7 days before the start of the camp with the following details:

1. Flight number
2. Airline Company
3. Departure and arrival time



Transport Madrid, Santander, Bilbao Airport:

- Individual travel: Check with campamentos@360camp.es
- Trip for 2 campers: 275€ / camper
- Trip 3 or more campers: 200€ / camper

Pick-up times at the airport: from 8am to 6pm

Airport drop-off times: from 9am to 8pm

2. ALBERGUE LOS ARRANES AT VILLAMEDIANA DE LOMAS, BURGOS, SPAIN

- The reception of campers will be at 17:00h on the first day.
- The departure and collection of participants will take place on the last day at 12:00h. If parents/legal guardians can't pick up the camper on the last day, they must provide authorisation with the details of the person who will pick them up.

3. BUS TRANSPORT SERVICE FROM BURGOS CITY CENTRE

The bus transport service will cost 45€.

- Departure time and place: 15:30h - C/Chopera, Burgos.
- Time and place of arrival: 14:00h - C/Chopera, Burgos.

TIPS

For younger campers who are not yet in control of their clothing changes, they can put their clothes in bags per day and it is recommended that they put in a few more changes.

It is recommended that all clothes and objects are labelled.

Remember that one night they are going to sleep in a tent, so if the sleeping bag is too thin, take a support blanket with them. If you have to buy a sleeping bag, look for a bag with a 5°C comfort temperature.

Burgos

Located 80 km away.

It is worth visiting Burgos, strolling through its elegant streets, promenades and green areas, contemplating its gothic cathedral, a World Heritage Site, and enjoying its gastronomy, increasingly recognised nationally and internationally. Burgos is also known for the Museum of Human Evolution, located next to the Arlanzón River, and the Atapuerca archaeological sites, just 10 km from the capital, which every day surprise us with new discoveries that allow us to decipher the origins of the human species.

Don't hesitate, enjoy a few days in this fantastic city, some of the best places to see (apart from the Cathedral and the Museum of Human Evolution) are the Monastery of Huelgas Reales, the Monastery of S.Pedro de Cardena, La Cartuja de Miraflores, the Castle and the Wall...



Santander

Located 93 km away.

Santander is, without doubt, one of the most beautiful cities of the Cantabrian coast in Spain, which reaches its tourist peak in the summer season.

Orbaneja del Castillo

Located 15 km away.

A medieval village, a beautiful waterfall and the imposing canyon of the river Ebro make Orbaneja possibly the most beautiful village in the province of Burgos.

Its imposing waterfall, more than 25 metres high, has created small stone terraces. You can visit the cave, the exact point where the spring emerges and divides the village into two distinct halves.



Covarrubias

Located 123 km away.

Covarrubias, declared a National Historic-Artistic Site in 1965 and a Historic Site in 2001, has Celtiberian, Roman, Visigothic, medieval and Baroque essences in its houses, streets and monuments, and in its natural surroundings, making it one of the most interesting and emblematic places in the province of Burgos.

Covarrubias is a very active town. A good example of this is the numerous events that the town hosts, be they cultural, gastronomic, sporting or traditional events...
